BOARD NOMINATIONS

Opening September 23, 2024

To be considered eligible for appointment to the NGC Board, a candidate must be deemed in good standing with NSGIC through a formal partnership (e.g., state representation, business partner, retired members, partner organization liaison, and/or industry professional) and agree to serve if appointed. Additionally, the candidate must not be currently serving as a Director on the NSGIC Board

Each Director shall serve a two-year term. Directors shall be eligible for re-appointment up to three (3) consecutive terms. New Board Director terms will begin on January 1st of each year.

To nominate a candidate, please submit via the NGC website on or after September 23 until October 31, 2024.
